

Traveling with a Dog?

HOUSE RULES FOR DOG VISITORS:

Pooper Scooper Law: \$250.

Please put some bags in your pocket before you leave.

I have trash receptacles in the back of the inn.

From the time you and your buddy step out of your car in Ocean City, you are responsible.

Do not disturb other guests.

If you think your dog is going to be barking or lonely please arrange a dog sitter.

Dog sitting is \$7 an hour and lots of love will go into it. We usually have one of our staff, or children, dog sit in your room. If the dog needs to go out, an adult will accompany them.

Last summer, the dog sitters were very busy. So, if you need to schedule, please give us dates and times in

advance, so they may be available to you.

Leaving the dog alone?

To respect the other guests, dogs should not be left to bark in room.

When you leave your dog, put your cell phone number under the door in the kitchen. I need to be able to reach you about your precious buddy. Thank you.

Shedding and hair control.

It helps if you brush your dog well before you come.

Sorry, I do not take cats! (My son is allergic.)

- Dog food
- Leash
- Scrap towels for after beach clean up
- Dog bed or blanket
- Ball, toys
